





# MAGOME WALKING MAP

## ★ Apple, Yuzu, and Walnut Trees

Magome area is home to an abundance of fruit trees. You can purchase products grown and processed by these farms at the Fureai Market and roadside station etc



## ★ Kumano Shrine

The all-night lights are a symbol of the shrine. Since the Edo period, local residents have handed down the practice of lighting the candles every day.



## ★ Magome Rice Terrace Scenery

Terraced rice fields of various sizes are dotted around the mountain sides. Watered paddy fields reflect the blue sky and Mount Ena, making the view even more spectacular!



## Mount Bonten

A place where trees found in warm regions can be seen at the same time

## ★ Ochiai Stone Pavement

This stone pavement runs a length of 840 m. A rare find today due to deterioration and other reasons, the stone pavements gives visitors a sense of how it felt to walk the Nakasendo.



## ★ Shimada Park

Close to the post town. The light-up during the autumnal leaves season is a must-see.
